

Laser Periodontal Therapy (SRP)

We recommend that all our patients needing extensive subgingival cleaning due to periodontal disease have their teeth and gums decontaminated and cauterized with our laser during their cleaning reservations. The laser treatment destroys otherwise inaccessible bacteria and cauterizes tissue while simultaneously creating an ideal environment for healing.

Why We Recommend Periodontal Laser Therapy

Boosts the immune system

Reduces the severity of other diseases

Kills periodontal disease bacteria:

The laser stops infections before it causes physical destruction of loss of bony support around your teeth.

Reduces or eliminates bacteria:

During a cleaning if your gums bleed, it allows bacteria to flood into the bloodstream and may cause infection in other areas of the body.

Prevents cross contamination:

Decontamination minimizes the chance that we inadvertently pick up bacterial infection in one area of the mouth and move it to another.

Cauterizes diseased tissues

The periodontal laser therapy process is painless and normally takes about 5-15 minutes with an investment of \$54 per quadrant of the mouth plus \$25 for the laser tip. This treatment is not covered by insurance plans at this time. However, periodontal laser therapy is typically reimbursed and payable to most Flex or HSA plans.
